



# FY22 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program

## Network Hardware Replacement Application - Summary Sheet

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### Program Overview

The **State & Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP)** is a reimbursement grant administered by the **Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)** and distributed through the **Montana Department of Emergency Services (MT DES)**.

This program provides essential funding to Montana counties, local governments, and K-12 public schools for upgrading critical network infrastructure to enhance cybersecurity posture and protect against evolving cyber threats.

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### Reimbursement Process

The SLCGP operates on a reimbursement basis, meaning funds are disbursed after eligible purchases are completed and documented. Key aspects include:

- Grant funds are provided as reimbursement payments after purchases are completed
- Awardees must submit reimbursement requests after the purchase is made and the vendor invoice is paid
- Organizations utilizing a managed service provider for IT services will be responsible for direct payment to the provider prior to requesting reimbursement from MT DES
- **No cost-sharing requirement** - Eligible expenses are 100% reimbursable

### Procurement Requirements

To ensure proper use of federal funds, all purchases made under this grant program must comply with established procurement standards. Recipients of SLCGP funding are responsible for compliance with:

- Their standard procurement policies and procedures
- Federal procurement guidelines under **2 CFR Part 200** (Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards)
